



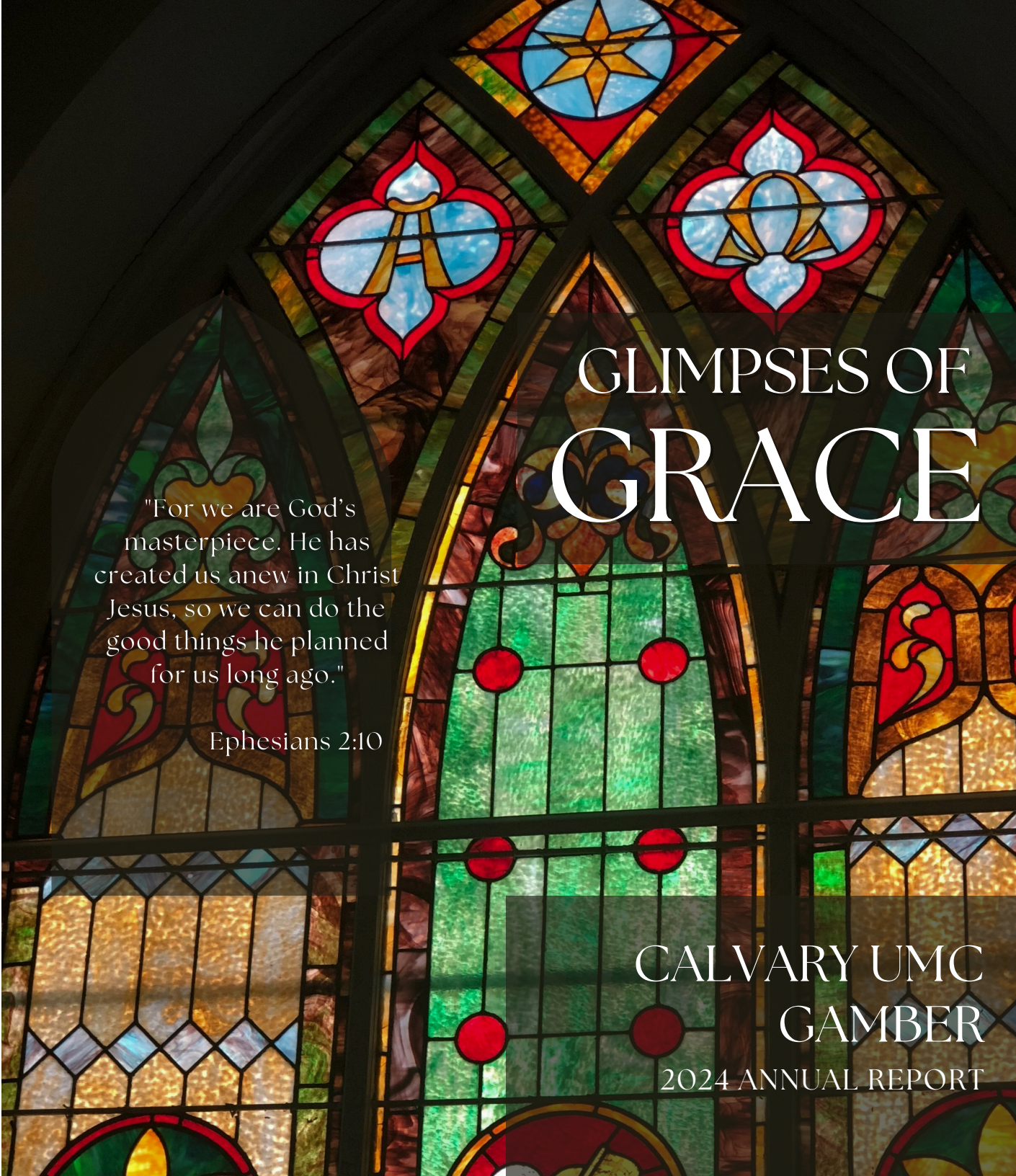
CURRENT ACCOUNTS

Where do our Funds come from?

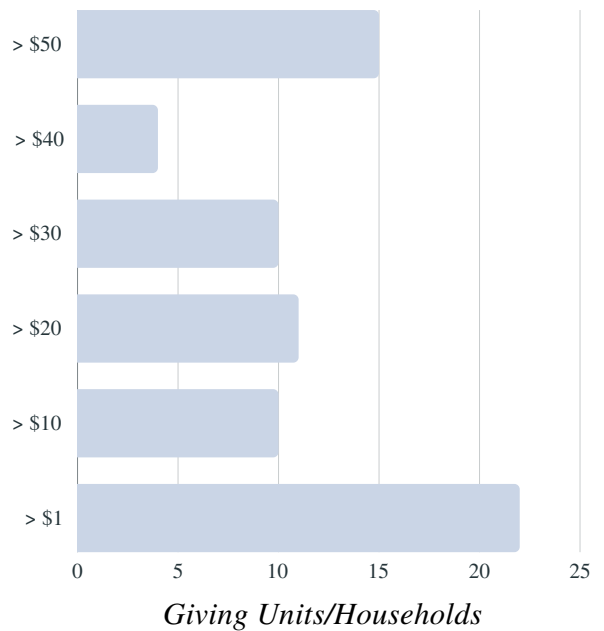

Narrative Giving Report

Among the **148** members of Calvary, we estimate approximately **100** "giving units" within our church—families, individuals, or households that worship together. Below is a breakdown of the weekly giving this year from our **72** active giving units at Calvary. This chart shows the portion of our offerings contributed by each giving level. Notably, 19 members contribute nearly three-quarters of our total collection.



As we enter 2025, we are mindful of an expected 13% decrease in worship offerings due to members relocating who have been significant contributors.
